



The **red line** in the graph above demonstrates a scenario in which LPS enrollment will stabilize at 14,827.

The **green line** demonstrates how five-year averaging continues to affect LPS, even years after enrollment stabilizes. The green line shows the average per-pupil funding LPS receives. Notice that in some years, LPS received funding for as many as 400 students more than it actually had.

Due to five-year averaging, LPS continues to receive funding for hundreds of students it no longer has. As enrollment stabilizes, the number of students LPS receives funding for and the actual pupil count move closer together.
