The tier two intervention of WIN will be assigned to all identified students. The tier three intervention of Team will be assigned to students not responding to tier two. Individual plans will be created for each student to achieve success. Teachers will monitor the plan daily. Students will be instructed in study skills, organizational skills, motivational techniques and focus on passing the quarterly SMART goals. Each Team student will complete the 'WhyTry' program.
