




Q.3: During the past 30 days, how often did you go hungry because there was not enough food in your home?


#### Q.4: My family expects me to attend school every day.






## Q.7: In the past year, how much time did you spend learning in-person?




#### Q.7: COVID-19 has been hard on me and my family.









#### Q.1: Adults in my school treat all students fairly.











# Q.2: How often do students get into physical fights at your school?





## Q.3: How likely is it that someone from your school will bully you online?






## Q.5: If a student is bullied in school, how difficult is it for him/her to get help from an adult?




