Summary

Topic Description	Results
Barriers to Engagement Factors that can create challenges for families to interact with or become involved with their child's school. Survey-takers responded to the question, "How big of a problem are the following issues for becoming involved with your child's current school?"	82%
Family Efficacy How confident families are with regard to key parenting skills.	70%
Family Engagement The degree to which families become involved with and interact with their child's school.	88%
Family Support Families' perceptions of the amount of academic and social support that they provide their child with outside of school.	60%
School Climate Perceptions of the overall social and learning climate of the school.	79%
School Fit Families' perceptions of how well a school matches their child's developmental needs.	70%
School Safety Perceptions of student physical and psychological safety at school.	78%





Q.2: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: How busy your schedule is?






Q.4: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: You feel unsure about how to communicate with the school?




Q.5: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: The school provides little information about involvement opportunities?





Q.6: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: The school is not welcoming to parents?














Q.3: To what extent do you know how your child is doing socially at school?












Q.5: Overall, how much respect do you think the teachers at your child's school have for the children?






Q.7: My child is positively connected to at least one peer at school.








Q.3: At your child's school, how well does the overall approach to discipline work for your child?

Q.4: How comfortable is your child in asking for help from school adults?







Q.1: My child knows how to get help at school if they are worried about themselves or a friend.







Q.3: If a student is bullied at your child's school, how difficult is it for their to get help from an adult?





Q.4: How likely is it that someone from your child's school will bully them online?








