We Love Our Volunteers!!

There are so many ways to help and we couldn't do it without you. Our families are asked to serve 20 hours of volunteering per school year. We offer many ways for you to reach this goal, through fundraisers and social events, as well as providing much needed help for our wonderful teaching staff. Some examples are:

- Attending a POPS meeting may equal 1 to 1.5 hours
- Attending a Governing Board meeting may equal 2 or more hours
- Used Uniform Sale may equal 2 or more hours
- Book Fairs may equal 2 or more hours
- Movie Night may equal 2 or more hours
- Griffin Gallup may equal 3 or more hours.

One of the easiest ways to help is to sign up for Hospitality. This is the committee that provides food for our various events. We use Sign Up genius in order to share the workload. Most families do not realize that all the shopping, baking/cooking time, and delivery are countable hours.

You may be thinking there are not enough opportunities to go around but do not worry; there are many more opportunities out there. Use the Volunteer sign up form to indicate which events you might like to help with. Signing up does not guarantee you will be called nor does it commit you to anything but please be aware that we do our best to accommodate our families.

It is very important for you to keep track of all your volunteer hours. Each month we send a detailed report to the district showing how and where our families have served. Your volunteer hours are due on the last day of each month. We realize that sometimes life gets in the way and you may forget to turn in your hours. That is why we accept hours all year long. If you realize in November that you forgot something from September, it is not too late to turn in those hours. Just be sure to indicate the correct month, activity and how much time.

In December we will be sending out a reminder for parents to turn in all hours and in January we will be sending out a reminder note to the parents letting them know how many hours they have turned in so far.

There is a form on the POPS page of the school website under Forms and Info. Save this form on your computer and fill it out each month. You can email it to our VIPS coordinator at lpcsvips@gmail.com or print the form and turn it into the POPS basket in the office. Additionally, we accept any form of email or written document as long as you include, month, activity, # of hours, and youngest or only child's name as well as your name and a way to contact you.
